ECO CHRISTMAS CARD PLEDGE

Last year we made a pledge to a more sustainable, alternative policy for Christmas card giving. We do appreciate that card giving is a fun part of Christmas, so we have come up with an alternative suggestion to ensure the joy of the

festive season is still maintained.

Some interesting (and devastating) facts about Christmas cards

- Over 1 billion cards are given each year in the UK!
- It takes one tree to make approximately 3000 cards, so each school would be responsible for potentially several trees being felled for this one Christmas tradition.
- If a class of approximately 30 children give a card to all 30 others, then the total amount for EACH CLASS is approximately 900 cards!

Let's do the maths

• If a primary school has 1 class per year x 30 pupils per (7) years that will = over 6000 cards exchanged per Christmas and 2 trees felled.

In the light of this we made a decision last year about an alternative to individual cards. If your child would like to they will be able to bring in one card for all the children and adults in the class (rather than writing out cards to individuals). These will be displayed in the classroom.
