## **BEHAVIOUR AT FPS**



I wanted to take a moment to share an update on our approach to behaviour at school. Over the past year, we have made some changes to our expectations and strategies to ensure a consistent and positive environment for all students.

As part of this, all staff have received training, and we have also reviewed our core values, which were outlined in the first flyer of this academic year. These values are displayed on staff lanyards and are regularly reinforced with the children, particularly when addressing any behaviour concerns.

Where possible, we aim to link consequences directly to behaviour. For example:

- If a child disrupts a task, they will be expected to complete it during break or lunchtime.
- If a child causes damage, they will assist with repairs where practical and appropriate.


Serious incidents are always recorded, and parents are informed accordingly.

The Senior Leadership Team actively monitors behaviour through incident reports, learning walks, and key times such as lunchtime to ensure a supportive and respectful school environment.
